

Local Rules

CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE

Out of bounds (MLR A-1)

Out of bounds on holes 1,2,3,15,16 and 18 is defined by the line between the course-side points of white stakes at ground level.

Dropping zones (MLR E-1.1)

Hole 7: If a player's ball comes to rest in the penalty area, as an additional option, the player may: Take relief, under one stroke penalty, by dropping the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone on the right hand side of the hole.

Hole 17: If a player's ball comes to rest in the left hand side penalty area (beyond the path), the player may: Take relief, under one stroke penalty, by dropping the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone near the bridge.

Protection of young trees (MLR E-10.1)

The young trees identified by wooden stakes or plastic rings are no play zones.

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's area of intended stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

Defining abnormal course conditions (MLR F-1)

Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line.

Electric fences on holes 4 and 15 are immovable obstructions and free relief is available under Rule 16.1b.

All gravel surfaced roads are immovable obstructions and free relief is available under Rule 16.1b.

Areas in bunkers where sand has been removed by the movement of water resulting in deep furrows through the sand are ground under repair.

Tree stumps are ground under repair and free relief is available under Rule 16.1.

All cherry laurels are ground under repair and free relief is available under rule 16.1b.

Area encircled with red and white ribbon on hole 13 is ground under repair and relief under rule 16.1 is available. As an additional option player may without penalty drop their ball in drop zone and continue from there.

Bunkers with no sand inside marked with blue stakes are ground under repair in general area and free relief under rule no. 16.1. is available

MLR E-3 (preferred lies)

When any part of player's ball touches part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, player may take free relief by placing their ball in one club length relief area.

Bunkers filled with temporary water (MRL F-16)

Bunkers filled with temporary water marked with blue stakes are ground under repair in the general area and free relief is available under Rule 16.1b.
